## **NOTES**

Very occasional annotations by the same hand that transcribed the main text record variant readings next to lines of the *RVF* and *Triumph*. At fol. 74r, next to *RVF* 268 a note by a different hand indicates the beginning of the second part of *RVF* ('Qui comincia ialcanto doppo lam[ ] laura'). At the bottom of fol. IIIr is a note by a later hand '[++] et correxit michael fonillanij pro officio s[anc]te Jnquisitionis'.

Decorated initials in pen for *RVF* 1 (fol. 1r), *RVF* 264 (fol. 72r), *Triumphus Amoris* I (fol. 103v), *Fame*

Ia (fol. 122r), *Fame* III (fol. 126r), *Temporis* (fol. 128r), and *Eternitatis* (fol. 130r); few *maniculae*.
