fols. 97r-134r: *RVF* 264-366;

fol. 134r: colophon: *Finita lamorte dellaura [sic]*;

fol. 134v: *RVF* 349, followed by the note by the same hand ('questo sonetto segue dirieto aquello sonetto chedicie dapiù belli occhi etdal più chiaro uiso');

fols. 135r-136v: blank;

fols. 137r-170v: *Triumph* (order: *Mortis* II, *Fame* Ia, *Amoris* II, *Amoris* I, *Amoris* III, *Amoris* IV, *Pudicitie*, *Mortis* Ia, *Mortis* I, *Fame* I, *Fame* II, *Fame* III, *Temporis*, *Eternitatis*);

fol. 170v: colophon: *Finiti itriunfi dimesser Francescho Petrarca poeta fiorentino*.

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NOTES

Scattered marginal annotations by a different hand either give variant readings or add missing lines; a different hand added a running header for each *RVF* poem and the number of the fol. where each poem is copied in the alphabetical index; some *maniculae*.

Decorated initials for *RVF* 1 (fol. 7r), *RVF* 264 (fol. 97r), the beginning of each *Triumphus* and each subsequent *capitolo*.
