## NOTES

Occasional marginal annotations by the same hand or another sixteenth-century hand point out the names mentioned or the rhetorical figures used in the poems.

The metrical form of each *RVF* poem and a running number are written in the same hand next to the first line of every poem (e.g., 'Sonetto primo' or 'canzone terza').

Decorated initial in gold for *RVF* 1 (fol. 1r); at fol. 1r is an architectural frame with a coat of arms within a wreath at the bottom of the fol.
