fols. 93r-139r: 33 *canzoni* from *RVF*, 'Canzone del petrarcha doueano stare tra sonetti doue stan[n] descripti iloro primi versi' (the first *canzone* is *RVF* 23, and the last one *RVF* 325.1-90);

NOTES

In the fols. containing the *RVF* sonnets, the first line of each *canzone* is written by the same hand after or next to the end of the sonnet that precedes it in order to signal the *canzone's* position in the book of rhymes. In those fols. containing *RVF canzoni*, a similar technique is used: each *canzone* is

preceded by a note by the same hand indicating the first line of the sonnet that comes before the relative *canzone* within *RVF*.

In the index of the *canzoni* of *RVF* (fol. 8r), reference is made to three *canzoni* beginning with the letter 'V' (i.e. *RVF* 29, 119, and 366), even though these poems have not been copied out. Furthermore, *RVF* 325 is left unfinished (the last line copied is the first half of l. 90).

Decorated initial in gold for *RVF* 1 (fol. 10r) and decorated initial for *RVF* 23 (fol. 93r); at fol. 10r is an architectural frame.
