fol. 4v: Petrarch's note on Laura by a different late-fifteenth-century hand ('Francisci Petrarcha Epi[stula], <inc> Laura proprijs uirtutibus illustris et meis longu[m] celebrata carminib[u]s; <exp> i[n]expectatos exitus acriter ac viriliter cogitantj);

fols. 5r-50r: *Triumphi* ('Francisci Petrarchae poetae flor[entini] triumphus amoris', order: *Amoris I, Amoris III, Amoris II.1-127 and 178-187, Amoris IV, Pudicitie, Mortis Ia, Mortis I, Mortis II, Fame Ia, Fame I, Fame II, Fame III, Temporis, Eternitatis*) with fol. 15 blank;

fol. 50r: colophon: Amen. Deogratias;

fol. 50r: three-line Latin epitaph for Petrarch by a different hand ('Epithaphiu[m]', <inc> Frigida francisci lapis hic tegit ossa petrarce);

fol. 50v: blank;

fols. 51r-118v: 147 *RVF* poems (hand A wrote nine *RVF* poems: the first one is *RVF* 129, the last one *RVF* 366 (fol. 62r) [followed by a colophon (fol. 62r): finis amen (erased)]; hand B wrote 138 *RVF* poems: the first one is *RVF* 36, the last one is *RVF* 310) with fol. 114 blank;

fol. 118v: colophon: finitas. Finis laus deo. ogi q[uest]o dj 28 die sestu feb[r]jarj perme danjello d[i]piero betti edetto libro e didetto danjiello.
