fol. 52r: full-page illumination (with Petrarch sitting under some trees and Laura standing on his right, below whom is Apollo chasing Daphne) within a rich architectural frame;

fol. 193r-193v: blank;

fols. 194r-200r: alphabetical index of the first lines of *RVF* poems (under each letter of the alphabet, poems are listed in order of appearance);

fols. 200v-201v: blank.

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NOTES

Occasional marginal annotations by a later hand provide some missing lines.

Historiated initial for *RVF* 1 showing Petrarch praying (fol. 54r); decorated initials in gold for every *capitolo* of the *Triumphs* and every *RVF* poem; at fols. 2r, 16r, 22r, 30r, 42r, 47r, 52r, and 54r, richly decorated architectural frames; at the bottom of fols. 2r, 16r, 42r, and 52r, four coats of arms (of an unknown family, of the Orsini, Farnese, and Della Rovere family, respectively).
