NOTES

The oval frame surrounding Petrarch's portrait contains verses *RVF* 347, 10-11: 'mai non volsi altro da te che 'l sol de li occhi tuoi'. The one surrounding Laura's portrait contains the verse *Triumphus mortis* II 151: 'teco era il cor, a me gli occhi rivolsi'. Within the cartouche above, *Triumphus cupidinis* II, 40: 'non mai si dolce fiamma in duo core arse'.
