A1v-F3v: *Triumphs*; each triumph is preceded by a full-page woodcut: *Triumphus Amoris* (A1v), *Pudicitie* (B6v), *Triumphus Mortis* (C2v), *Triumphus Fame* (D2v), *Triumphus Temporis* (E5v), *Triumphus Eternitatis* (E8v). Marginal annotations printed throughout the edition include: brief summaries (e.g. 'Laude di Laura', 'Dolore dela morte di Laura', 'Contro le speranze degli homini', 'Breuita di nostra uita'), names of characters, speakers, and addressees (e.g., 'Laura', 'Poeta', 'Parla seco il poeta'), rhetorical elements (e.g., 'sententia', 'inuocatione', 'comparatione'), and moralizing *sententiae* ('Notate huomini mortali');

F4r-F7v: Bruni's life of Petrarch;

F8r: colophon: Finiscono ltrionphi di.M[esser]F[rancesco] Petrarcha insieme con lauita sua co[n] somma diligentia ben correcti & impressi in Venetia p[er] Nicolo ditto Zopino e Vince[n]zo co[m]pagno nel M.ccccc.xix. de Noue[m]briio, followed by the printer's mark [a seated bishop-saint];
