Q3r-Y2v: second part of *RVF* (beginning with *RVF* 267) with Vellutello's commentary;

Y3r-Cc1v: third part of *RVF* (beginning with *RVF* 128) with Vellutello's commentary;

Cc2r-Cc3r: poems addressed to Petrarch by Muzio Stramazzo da Perugia ('La santa Fiamma de laqual son priue'), Geri Gianfigliuzzi ('Messer Francesco chi d'amor sospira'), Giacomo Colonna ('Se le parti del corpo mio destrutte'), and Giovanni Dondi dall'Orologio ('Io non so ben s'io uedo quell,

ch'io ueggio'), each poem followed by the first line of Petrarch's reply accompanied by the page number where the poem is printed;
