fol. 9r: three-line Latin epitaph for Petrarch by the same hand ('decto poeta e sepellito adarquate in lobardia [sic] elsuo epitaphio e questo scripto', <inc> Frigida francisci lapis hic tegit ossa petrarce);

fols. 9r-15v: alphabetical index of the first lines of *RVF* poems (under each letter of the alphabet, poems are listed in order of appearance) ('Incomincia latauola delle canzone & sonecti dimessere francesco petrarcha');

fol. 16r: title ('LE | CANZONE | E | SONECTI') written in capital letters within a decorated circle;

fols. 16r-155v: *RVF*;

fol. 155v: colophon: Qui finisce lecanzone & sonecti del petrarcha poeta excellentissimo.
