Fols. 1¹-8¹: annotations are due to Vincenzo Follini (1759-1836), librarian at the Biblioteca Magliabechiana, Florence.

Sonnet 'Donna che lieta colprincipio nostro' has been copied twice, at fols. 119r-119v and at fol. 127v. In the latter fol., next to the first line of the sonnet, there is a marginal annotation stating that the poem has been already written as *RVF 331* ('eschritto unaltra uolta a fō 331').

At fols. 7r and fol. 135r, there is an architectural frame with floral decorations; numerous *maniculae*.
