NOTES

At fol. 179r: two annotations by a later hand comment on historical figures: 'il granchartaginese: annibale'; 'ilre Filippo: padre dalexandro'.

Fol. 11r has a white vine-stem decorated architectural frame with a coat of arms at the bottom of the fol. representing the claws of two grey lions; decorated initials for *RVF* 1-2 at fol. 11r. Decorated initials in gold with decorated borders for *RVF* 267 (fol. 112v) and *Triumphus Amoris* I (fol. 153r).
