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NOTES

Fol. 1r has a rectangular-box illumination showing a man chasing a woman within a floral decorated architectural frame and a partially erased coat of arms presumably belonging to the Piccolomini family at the bottom of the fol. Fol. 140r has a rectangular-box illumination showing the chariot of Love towed by two white horses on which a Cupid is shooting an arrow within a floral decorated architectural frame. Historiated initial for *RVF* 1 at fol. 1r representing Petrarch in a pink habit holding a green book. Decorated initials in gold with a decorated border for *RVF* 246 (fol. 98r), each *Triumphus* (fols. 140r, 152r, 156v, 164r, 172v, and 174r), Bruni's life (fol. 177r), and the final index of *RVF* (fol. 185r). There is a running header for each *RVF* poem.

After fol. 63 a fol. containing *RVF* 136-139 has been entirely ripped off.
