**NOTES**

This is the ms. that Aldus Manutius used to prepare his editions of *Le cose volgari di messer Francesco Petrarca* (1501) and *Le terze rime di Dante* (1502).

Marginal and interlinear annotations (by Bembo) provide orthographical corrections and variant readings of the poems.

Bembo copied *RVF* poems in the following order: *RVF* 1-229, 264-294, 230-263, and 295-366. Before the beginning of the section *RVF* 295-366, he wrote a note (at fol. 113v) to indicate that the quire beginning with *RVF* 264 (and containing *RVF* 265-294) was to be inserted here.

Some quires of volume II are missing and the remaining ones were bound in the wrong order (and this has affected the presentation of Dante's work).
