## NOTES

Occasional marginal annotations by a humanistic hand add a few missing lines; some *maniculae*. At fol. 35r some annotations by a later hand refer to past shelfmarks and, possibly, to some possessors of the ms. (the possession note was washed).

Fol. 4 is missing. Historiated initial in gold for *Triumphus Mortis* II showing Petrarch's head (fol. 5r); decorated initials for all the other *capitoli* of the *Triumphi* and Zenone da Pistoia's *Pietosa fonte*; at fol. 5r is an architectural frame with, at its bottom, a coat of arms.
