a1v-e3r [wrongly printed as a3r]: *Triumphs*; each triumph is preceded by a full-page woodcut: *Triumphus Amoris* (a1v), *Pudicitie* (b3v), *Mortis* (b6v), *Fame* (c4r), *Temporis* (d4v), *Eternitatis* (e1r). Marginal annotations printed throughout the edition include: brief summaries (e.g. 'Laude di Laura', 'Laude di Scipione', 'Affecti degli innamorati'), names of characters, speakers, and addressees (e.g., 'Parole di Massinissa al poeta', 'Risposta di Laura', 'Parole del Poeta'), rhetorical elements (e.g., 'bel decto', 'risposta bella', 'comparatione'), and moralizing *sententiae* ('Notate huomini mortali' and 'Notate ricchi'); e3r: colophon: Finis Petrarcae;

e3v: blank;
