Ch'ad hora ad hora', 'Ingegno usato alle question profonde', 'Stato foss'io, quando la uidi prima', 'In ira a i cieli, al mondo, & alla gente', 'Se sotto legge Amor uiuesse quella', 'Lasso com'io fui mal proueduto', 'Quella, che 'l giouenil mio cor auinse');

C2v-C4r: poems addressed to Petrarch by Geri Gianfigliuzzi ('Messer Francesco chi d'amor sospira'), Giovanni Dondi dall'Orologio ('Io non so ben s'io uedo quel, ch'io ueggio'), Sennuccio del Bene ('Oltra l'usato modo si regira'), Giacomo Colonna ('Se le parti del corpo mio destrutte'), each poem is followed by the first line of Petrarch's reply accompanied by the page number where the poem is printed;

C4r-C7v: three *canzoni* by Guido Cavalcanti ('Donna mi prega: perche uoglio dire'), Dante Alighieri ('Cosi nel mio parlar uoglio esser aspro'), and Cino da Pistoia ('La dolce uista, e 'l bel guardo soave');

C8r: list of errata;

C8v: Manutius printer's mark.

Notes: the beginning of the 'rime in morte' comes later (with *RVF* 267) compared to the 1501 Aldine *RVF* edition.

NOTES

One of the John Rylands Library copies (Aldine Collection 125(1)) is on vellum. In this edition, *Triumphus Fame* Ia (fols. y1r-y3v) is printed instead of *Triumphus Fame* I, and the headings of the following two *capitoli* of the *Triumphus* (i.e., *Triumphus Fame* II and *Triumphus Fame* III) diverge from those printed in the paper copies (i.e., Manchester, John Rylands Library, Aldine Collection 125(2) and Manchester, John Rylands Library, Aldine Collection 125(3)): 'DEL TRIOMPHO DELLA | FAMA CAPITOL • I I •' (on vellum copy) instead of 'DEL TRIOMPHO DEL | LA FAMA CAPI | TOL. I I •' (on paper copy); and 'DEL TRIOMPHO DELLA | FAMA CAPITOL • I I I •' (on vellum copy) instead of 'DEL TRIOMPHO DEL | LA FAMA CAPI | TOL. I I I •' (on paper copy).
