fols. 128r-155v: *Triumphi* with annotations ('Incomicia il libro de trunfi del uenerabile poeta fiorentino mes[er] francescho petrarcha'; order: *Mortis* II, *Fame* Ia, *Amoris* II, *Amoris* I, *Amoris* III, *Amoris* IV, *Pudicitie* (in a shortened and altered version, lines 1-100), *Mortis* I, *Fame* I, *Fame* II, *Fame* III, *Temporis*, *Eternitatis*);

fol. 155v: colophon: EXPLICIT;

fol. 156r: blank.

Other contents:

fol. 156v: first paragraph of [Arrigo da Settimello's] 'Trattato contro all'avversità della fortuna' by the same hand who transcribed the annotations (<inc> Adiritamente e bene uiuere la natura medesima ci chiama; <exp> Alcuno e laltro sono aparecchiati rimedij);

fols. 157r-170v: books 1-4 of [Arrigo da Settimello's] 'Trattato contro all'avversità della fortuna' with marginal annotation by the same hand that transcribed the main text (<inc> A diritamente ebene uiuere la natura medesma ci chiama; <exp> et di quelle cose che fanno igius[—] amico uosti [sic] comandamenti tu infermo atray uolentieri);

fols. 171r-171v: copy of paragraphs of [Arrigo da Settimello's] 'Trattato contro all'avversità della fortuna' (<inc> Corrado cagione de la nostra salute perche peri; <exp> sopra ogni cosa uilissima et fit†da).

NOTES

The annotations on the *Triumphi* (more extensive in the first half) are philological in character and deal with variant readings placed next to the relevant lines. The variant is recorded as follows: 'domita lalterezza delli iddei': 'Domita fu l'altezza degli Dei' (*Triumphus Pudicitie* 2, fol. 142r). More rarely, the annotator adds missing lines.

At fol. 149r is a sketched ink portrait of 'Cosimo'; few *maniculae*.

RVF begins at RVF 9.12 due to the loss of the initial fols.
