fols. 3r-5r: indexes of the first lines of other authors' poems listed in order of appearance and with metre specified;

fols. 5v-11v: blank;

fols. 12r-36r: extensive selection of 183 poems from *RVF* and additional *disperse*, including some correspondence poems by other authors (within this series the following poems are mistakenly attributed to Petrarch: 'J lampeggiar degl'occhi alteri egrai' by Matteo degli Albizzi at fol. 13v, 'Neltempo chessinfiora etchuopre derba' by Fazio degli Uberti at fol. 23v);

fols. 93v-94v: Boccaccio's letter to Franceschino de' Bardi composed of a foreword and a letter in Neapolitan dialect ('Questa presente lettera mando messer giouanni boccacci danapoli aJacopo uillani esendo nella corte dellonperadore Jnpresenza diacopo delle botte efratelli'; <inc of foreword> Concio sia chosa che lle forze degli huo[mini]; <exp of foreword> p[er]diporto dinoi medesimi ti scriuiamo; <inc of Neapolitan letter> facimote adunque caro frat\i\ello assapire challo primo Jorno; <exp of Neapolitan letter> Jnapule lo juorno de santaniello dalli toi).
