fol. 9r-16r: alphabetical index of the first lines of *RVF* poems (under each letter of the alphabet, poems are listed in order of appearance);

### **NOTES**

Annotations are by the same hand that transcribed the main text next to lines of *RVF* poems and, more extensively, to the *Triumph*. This is one of the few mss. to provide *varianti d'autore* for the *Triumph* (Pacca 1996, 5). These variant readings are introduced by 'at' or 'd.p.' (e.g. next to the lines of *Triumphus Amoris* III.184-186, the copyist writes 'd.p. che pocho d[olce] m[olto] a[maro] a pagha e qui f[+]na a cap[itol]o agiunse poi'). There is a running header in red ink next to the first line of each *RVF* poem.

Fol. 19r has a three-side architectural frame with white vine-stem decoration and a partly erased coat of arms at the bottom of the fol. Fol. 173r has decorated borders in the left and top borders. Decorated initials in gold with floral decoration for Bruni's life (fol. 1r), *RVF* 1 (fol. 19r), and for each *Triumphus* (fols. 173r, 186r, 190r, 197r, 207v, 210v).
