fol. 139r: colophon: deo gratias. Finitj isonettj etle chanzone dellaureato magnifico poeta mess[er] franc[esc]o petrarcha qui scripsit scribat semp[er] chumd[omi]no uiuat. amen;

fol. 139v: blank;

fols. 140r-176r: *Triumphus* (order: *Mortis* II, *Fame* Ia, *Amoris* II, *Amoris* I, *Amoris* III, *Amoris* IV, *Pudicitie*, *Mortis* I, *Fame* I, *Fame* II, *Fame* III, *Temporis*, *Eternitatis*, *Mortis* Ia);

fol. 176r: colophon: FINIS;

followed by a brief paragraph on *Triumphus Mortis* Ia: 'Questo capitolino e unchapitolo nonfinito cheseghujta quello che dice | quando ad ungiogho et inunte[m]po quiui domita lalterezza dellj de etcetc'; and by a second colophon: Amen finis Finitj itriumph [sic] delmagnificho laureato mess[er] franc[esc]o petrarcha poeta fiorentino Che scrissit scribat et semp[er] chumd[omi]no uiuat;

fols. 176v-178v: one *dispersa* (*frottola* 'Diridere o gran uoglia').

NOTES

There are two kinds of occasional annotations: 1) marginal annotations by the same hand that transcribed the main text record either variant readings or missing lines; 2) two annotations by a later hand (presumably sixteenth century) next to *RVF* 299 (fol. 111v: extensive remarks on the events related to its composition) and *Triumphus Fame* Ia (fol. 143r: noting that this *capitolo* is nowhere to be found in printed editions: 'Ne nuoui uolumi questo capitolino no[n] si legge').

Decorated initials in gold for *RVF* 1 (fol. 1r) and *Triumphus Amoris* I (fol. 140r); some *maniculae*.
